

Informative Ergonomics Presentation at November Meeting

The November SARI meeting featured a very informative program on workplace ergonomics, entitled “Economics & Financial Benefits of an Ergonomics Program”. The main speaker was William Cesare, PhD, CPE, who stressed that “Ergonomics is Good Economics”, and that companies need to be proactive in managing ergonomic programs, in order to avoid significant expenditures which can result from being reactive to ergonomic problems.

Zack Pereira, MS, PT, described the services offered by the Donley Center in Providence, where employees of Rhode Island companies can obtain comprehensive rehabilitation services for job-related injuries and illnesses (ergonomic injuries are classified as illnesses) at no cost.
